AVKS has also done awareness campaign to break the chain of spread Corona virus and remedies/steps to prevent it.



Manav Vikas Seva Sangh, Sagar, Madhya Pradesh



Manav Vikas Seva Sangh works in 350 villages in the districts of, Guna, Ashoknagar, Vidisha and Raisen and 15 slums in Sagar of Madhya Pradesh. The target families of these villages and slums are mostly daily wages laborers. The organisation actively involved in COVID relief work and has extended the following support.

1. Prepared masks and hand sanitizers and distributed it to over 20000 community members.
2. Providing Ration kits for 8000 families along with toiletry articles.
3. Provided cooked food kits daily for over 1000 street dwellers.
4. Engaged in awareness on safety measures in different junctions and villages.
5. Hospitalized the needy persons and took care of them.
6. Facilitated the children to do artistic work on COVID-19 awareness by the Child line Team of the organisation.

Apart from the above actions, the trained youth in garment making were facilitated to stitch over 75000 masks and the same were distributed. In a phased manner MVSS has reached out to a total of 197530 people through different activities.
